



COUTURE GLOVE MAKING

WITH MASTER GLOVEMAKER DANIEL STORTO

July 11 - 15, 2011 At The Academy of fine Sewing & Design

Daniel Storto is a Glove Haute Couturier based in Gloversville, NY. His gloves have graced the hands of numerous celebrities. He recreated all the gloves for the 2001 Metropolitan Museum of Art exhibition "Jacqueline Kennedy: The White House Years." Daniel's designs are works of art, all hand stitched from the finest Italian suedes and leathers. His work has appeared on the covers of Vogue, 2wice and American Craft. Working out of his storefront location in Gloversville, Daniel is surrounded by vintage tools, equipment and patterns as he produces his amazing works of art for the public to see.

Spend five full days creating your own couture gloves with Daniel Storto. Participants will make a custom fitted, hand stitched pair of gloves out of leather or suede. Daniel will be bringing some of his specialized equipment to demonstrate and for the students to use. This is a unique opportunity to study with a master. PROJECT and SUPPLIES

Students will practice glove making techniques while working on their own custom gloves. All supplies including pattern, leather, needles and thread will be supplied. Students will have some color and design choices.

LOCATION

The Academy of fine Sewing & Design is a fully equipped school and studio located in beautiful North Bay, Ontario, Canada. Students will enjoy the use of Bernina sewing machines. Professional pressing systems, full spectrum lighting, True Color Ott Lites, sewing kits with Gingher scissors and Olfa rotary cutters are some of the many supplies available for students to use. For this unique workshop, Daniel will be bringing a lot of specialized glove making equipment for the student's use. The Academy is situated amongst a beautiful maple forest – visible from the 7 large windows and only minutes away from North Bay's airport.

ACCOMMODATION

Rooms are available at the Hampton Inn for a special group rate of \$135 per night which includes breakfast. The Hampton Inn is located within walking distance of many restaurants. A reservation link to the Hampton Inn will be provided upon class registration. Daily shuttle service between the hotel and school can be provided if required.

TUITION FEES

Class tuition of \$975 plus 13%HST includes 5 days of instruction, supplies to make a pair of gloves, all handouts, lunch and beverage breaks. A non-refundable deposit of \$300 will reserve your spot, with the remainder due by May 6, 2011. Class size is limited to 10 students providing maximum individual attention. In the event that you must cancel after May 6, half of the balance will be returned to you. If your space can be filled the other half will be refunded. If you cancel after June 26, no refund will be given. In the event that the course is cancelled students will be fully reimbursed. It is recommended that you consider purchasing private cancellation insurance.
