



DESIGNER T-SHIRTS

With Ce Podolak and Kathryn Brenne

September 10-11, 2010 at The Academy of Fine Sewing & Design

Cecelia Podolak sews, teaches, writes and designs from her studio in Port Moody, B.C., Canada. Her Classics Pattern Line is designed for real bodies. She is the author of the best selling book, Easy Guide to Sewing Jackets. She is an experienced university professor and has her own company, Material Things.

Designer T-shirts and knit garments can cost a small fortune but are quite simple to make. Start with Ce's best selling Fearless T-shirt pattern # 109 as you learn to fit according to the amount of stretch found in the fabric. Based on her many articles on knits, Kathryn will teach students a variety of seam and hem finishes for both the sewing machine, serger and coverstitch machine. Get creative by adding embroidery, raw edges, fancy stitches, combine and seam fabrics together. Students will complete a variety of samples as well as their own T-shirt.

LOCATION

The Academy of fine Sewing & Design is a fully equipped school and studio located in beautiful North Bay, Ontario, Canada. Students will enjoy the use of Bernina sewing machines as well as industrial sewing machines. Professional pressing systems, full spectrum lighting, True Color Ott Lites, sewing kits with Gingher scissors and Fiskars rotary cutters are some of the many supplies available for students to use. The Academy is situated amongst a beautiful maple forest – visible from the 7 large windows and only minutes away from North Bay's airport.

PROJECT AND SUPPLIES

Students will have the option of creating a T-shirt or extending Ce's pattern into a T-shirt dress.

Students will be required to supply their own fabric, thread and notions. Patterns will be available for purchase at The Academy. Fabric for samples will be provided.

ACCOMODATION

Rooms are available at the Hampton Inn for the special rate of \$129/Queen and \$149/King CDN per night including breakfast. The Hampton Inn is located within walking distance of many restaurants. A reservation link to the Hampton Inn will be provided upon class registration. Daily shuttle service between the hotel and school can be provided if required.

TUITION FEES

Class tuition fee of \$250 CDN plus 5% GST includes two days of instruction, all handouts, fabric for samples, lunches and beverage breaks. A non-refundable deposit of \$100 CDN will reserve your spot, with the remainder due by June 30, 2010. Class size is limited to 10 students to provide maximum individualized attention. In the event that you must cancel after June 30, half of the balance will be returned to you. If your space can be filled the other half will be refunded. If you must cancel after August 27, no fees will be returned. In the event that the course is cancelled tuition fees will be fully reimbursed. It is recommended that you consider purchasing private cancellation insurance to cover any unforeseen circumstances which cause you to cancel.
