



## **SHEARLING JACKET WORKSHOP**

**With Kathryn Brenne**

*November 12-16, 2008 at The Academy of Fine Sewing & Design*

Treat yourself to a luxurious shearling jacket and a five-day sewing vacation! Based on her article for THREADS issue #104, leather expert Kathryn Brenne will guide you through the process of constructing a shearling jacket. This workshop begins with a shopping day in Toronto to visit wholesalers and purchase shearling for your garment. Students who have previously completed a shearling workshop may choose to remodel a fur garment and learn new construction techniques.

### **GARMENT**

Students are free to choose their own project. Shearling is fun to work with and is suitable for all levels of sewers! All students will be asked to bring a ready-to-fit muslin of their garment to class. Please feel free to call Kathryn Brenne to discuss your pattern selection.

### **LOCATION**

The Academy of fine Sewing & Design is a fully equipped school and studio located in beautiful North Bay, Ontario, Canada. Students will enjoy the use of Bernina sewing machines as well as industrial sewing machines. Professional pressing systems, full spectrum lighting, True Color Ott Lites, sewing kits with Gingher scissors and Fiskars rotary cutters are some of the many supplies available for students to use. The Academy is situated amongst a beautiful maple forest – visible from the 7 large windows and only minutes away from North Bay's airport.

### **ACCOMMODATION**

Students will meet in Toronto on November 12. We can suggest Toronto hotels for you. In North Bay Rooms are available at the Inn on the Bay 705-495-6461 or 1-877-937-8483 at the special rate of \$94 CDN per single or double under the name of Kathryn Brenne/The Academy of fine Sewing & Design. The Inn on the Bay has its own restaurant and is located in downtown North Bay within walking distance of many restaurants and our beautiful waterfront. Daily shuttle service between the hotel and school will be provided.

### **SUPPLIES**

A list of supplies and notions required will be sent out with the registration package.

### **TUITION FEES**

Class tuition fee of \$750 CDN/US plus 5% GST tax includes a shopping day in Toronto, four days of classroom instruction, all handouts, shearling for samples, daily shuttle service, all lunches and beverage breaks. A non-refundable deposit of \$200 CDN/US will reserve your spot, with the remainder due by September 1, 2008. Class size is limited to 5 students to provide maximum individualized attention. In the event that you must cancel after Sept. 1, half of the balance will be returned to you. If your space can be filled the other half will be refunded. In the event that the course is cancelled students will be fully reimbursed.
